

3. Important Financial Information

VERY IMPORTANT: In order to proceed with the registration process, you will need to upload the fee payer ID document

3.1 Bill of Costs

Should you require a Bill of Costs to apply for a loan or bursary, you are able to generate your own Bill of Costs <u>here</u>

For new students, make use of your fact sheet to select and generate your Bill of Costs. For returning students, make use of your Academic Progression Document to select and generate your own Bill of Costs.

3.2 Payment Methods

If you have reviewed the fee schedule you will know that multiple payment terms are available. You may also choose how you would like to make payment. These are as follows:

3.2 a) PAYU

You will be directed to the PAY U portal which is embedded within the registration process, and payment must take place at the point of registration. It is important to note that you will not be able to submit your registration until payment is made. The Full settlement or deposit for the 6-month option is due on/before registration.

3.2 b) Debit Orders

Debit Orders are run on the 1st, 15th or 25th of each month. If you have selected the 6-month payment plan, a debit order is mandatory. Please complete the debit order details when registering - you will be required to provide us with your Name, your Bank, your Branch Code, the Type of Account and the Account Name and Number. Debit orders are available for South African students, and international students with South African bank accounts. Unpaid/Returned Debit Orders will incur an administration charge of R300.

4. Student Information Systems and Single Sign On (SSO)

All Student Information Systems use the same username (ST number) and password, this is what is referred to as your Single Sign On (SSO)

For NEW students, you will receive information and onboarding on the various Student Information Systems during Orientation & Onboarding week. Keep a look out for communication via your VC connect email address and SMS.

5. Your Registration Confirmation

Once you have completed your registration and payment, your campus will finalise your registration. Thereafter you will receive the following:

- A confirmation of registration email (within 72 hours of finalisation)
- The link to Wizebooks to order your textbooks (within 72 hours of finalisation)
- Your SSO (Single Sign On) username (ST number) and password, which will be used to sign into your Student Information Systems
- Your institutional vcconnect email and Wifi

By receiving the final confirmation of registration, it means that you:

- 1. have met the entrance criteria,
- 2. uploaded all the correct documents,
- 3. your minimum payment due (deposit or full settlement) was received by us.

6. WizeBooks

Wizebooks is the preferred supplier of to Varsity College students. They have a customer centric solution that enables you to order books online which are delivered to you. Once you have submitted your registration, you will receive an invitation to order your books through Wizebooks. Your prepopulated cart will be based on the modules you selected when you registered so, please ensure that the correct modules are selected.

You will be required to log in using your new student number (starting with ST) and your ID number. We recommend that you do not order your books until you have received final confirmation of your registration from us in order to prevent a possible delay in the process.

The issuing of 2023 Student Cards will be done via the Wizebooks portal. When ordering your 2023 academic material, you will be required to upload a clear head and shoulders photo to be used on your student card. Your student card will then be delivered to you along with your academic material from Wizebooks.

7. Contract Amendments and Transfers

Should you wish to make an amendment to your registration contract, you are able to do so prior to selecting your modules and clicking submit.

Once you have selected your modules, clicked submit and made payment any module and/or fee related contract changes will need to be done by raising a query on <u>VC Assist</u>

Should you wish to transfer, or make an amendment to your contract, adjust your payment terms, amend your debit order and- please proceed to <u>VC Assist</u> - complete the form and raise your request.

8. Assessment Support Relating to Learning Concessions and Needs

As mentioned above - should you need to apply for this support concession – please proceed to \underline{VC} <u>Assist</u> and make your application. Select the query type **Assessment Support Relating to Learning Concessions and Needs,** complete the application, and submit your application together with the supporting documentation required. Should you need assistance - please contact the Online Centre.

9. Applying for an Academic Credit

Should you need to apply for a credit – please proceed to <u>VC Assist</u> – select **Student Hub** and select Internal or External Credits. Your application will be considered, and you will receive a response via VC Assist. Credit applications will be considered from the 26 May to 30 June 2023. Please ensure that you upload all the documentation to support your application. External credit application will carry a R250 evaluation fee per module.
